



FAQ's

We have put together the following FAQ's to answer some of your queries immediately, we understand that our services are completely unique and so may be outside of your staffs area of expertise when arranging school trips, but we are here to help you to provide your children with the most amazing experience outside of the classroom.

Can you come to our school?

Quite simply yes- we will be more than happy to visit your school to either

- Deliver packages- a 2hr or 24 hour camp can be run in your grounds
- Or Discuss your children visiting us with your staff
- Or Discuss your children visiting us with your parents

All you need to do is contact us to book an appointment and one of our senior instructors, people who will be delivering on the ground, will come out to meet with you.

Can I come and see your Centre?

You would be more than welcome to visit us, again just give us a call and we will arrange an appointment for you, our centres are based in Oxfordshire and Derbyshire.

What are your minimum numbers?

You will be pleased to now we do not have them! We deliver to both small and large groups. Your children may benefit from a working environment with smaller numbers, this can be used to encourage learning or as reward. We need to cover the cost of instructors, the effect on the land and our insurance, and will always commit to giving you our lowest possible price. For larger numbers your price per head will reduce, but for smaller numbers say of 8 you may only need one of our 11 instructors and so the price per head will be reflected in our quote.

Do you have maximum numbers?

Our current record is 158 students on one day... give us a call and challenge us to beat this. We can cater for up to 300 students at the current time.

Is food provided?

It can be, from preparing wild game, through to prepared meals from our caterers, it can all be delivered, or you may decide to bring your own meals, it is completely up to you- just complete the form with your wishes and we'll do the rest. We can cater for all special dietary requirements and have provided halal, vegetarian, kosher, pescetarian, celiac and lactose free in the past!

Will we need to provide teachers?

Obviously legislation makes it compulsory for at least one of your staff to accompany your students, and so the cost of your staff attending is usually free for up to 1 staff/8 pupils. There may be a surcharge for food. Besides, your staff will love it too!

During overnight camps where do people sleep?

You can just join us for a couple of hours or a day, but if you want the overnight experience we provide tents for both your male and female staff, and tented accommodation for your children, again separated for both male and female. We can even provide sleeping bags if you wish!

What about H&S?

All our team are enhance CRB Checked, we offer full £5million liability insurance, vulnerable persons policies are available for your inspection and each and every activity is rigorously risk assessed. We have the highest possible standards when it comes to first aid with each instructor being as a minimum Remote Emergency Care Level 2 first aid trained with the lead instructor holding the Level 4

Expedition REC qualification. We are also experts in the field where it comes to fire management, sanitation, food hygiene, and camp craft. We are also the ONLY bushcraft company in the industry that not only trains its own instructors, but also puts them through a continual programme of ongoing CPD.

So what about toilets?

At each centre there are purpose built toilets that are in keeping with our setting. Each toilet is screened with a purpose built Hazel wattle surround and are private. For larger groups we bring in portaloo's for your sanitation.

What about your instructor to children ratio's?

It depends on the activity but we guarantee you a minimum instructor ratio of 1 to 8 where there are high risk activities. We also guarantee every instructor is on site during the period of your stay, whether for 1 hour, 1 night or 1 week. We also have a mixture of both male and female instructors.

Can you train our own staff?

Absolutely, it doesn't have to be all about the children! We have trained outdoor leaders to the IOL Bushcraft Practitioner Award and we can train your teachers too. We not only deliver to school children as we also operate the largest Bushcraft school for adult courses also! Whether you wish your staff to be trained on friction fire lighting or how to incorporate wild foods into your science lessons, we can tailor it exactly to your needs.
