Woodland Ways will provide you with all the relevant equipment and materials for each specific Workshop but detailed below are some recommendations for additional things to bring with you.

Kit List

- Appropriate Footwear** – Use of cutting tools such as fixed blade knives, folding saws and axes demand that students wear enclosed toe footwear. Please do not wear sandals or any other open toe footwear.
- Clothing** – Parts of the session may take place immediately outside the World of Bushcraft Centre or in the surrounding countryside, so it is advisable to bring appropriate clothing for the weather on the day of your booking which may include waterproof jackets, warm jumpers and outdoor boots.
- Lunch** – Unless otherwise stated, please bring your own packed lunch for full day courses.

Partial-outdoor workshops include:

- **Friction Fire Lighting, Game Prep, Foraging, Knots & Rope work and Navigation**

Optional considerations

- Notebook** – Students may wish to bring a notebook to note down information covered during the session.
- Camera** – Depending how you learn, this may help with recording information covered.
- Snacks** – tea and coffee will be provided but feel free to bring any additional snacks you see fit.
